Datganiad Polisi Amgylcheddol

Mae Ymddiriedolaeth GIG Gwasanaethau Ambwlans Cymru (WAST) yn gwasanaethu Cymru gyfan. Oherwydd ei maint a natur y gwasanaethau y mae'n eu darparu, mae gan WAST nifer o agweddau amgylcheddol fydd, os na fyddan nhw'n cael eu rheoli'n ofalus, yn cael effaith ariannol ac amgylcheddol sylweddol. Fel rhan o'i hymrwymiad tuag at leihau'r effeithiau hyn, bydd y WAST yn gweithredu ac yn cynnal System Rheolaeth Amgylcheddol (EGS) fydd yn cael ei llunio i gyflawni'r egwyddorion allweddol canlynol:

- Cydymffurfio gyda gofynion cyfreithiol a gofynion eraill perthnasol
- Atal llygru
- Gwelliant parhaus

Cyflawnir rheolaeth amgylcheddol effeithlon drwy'r prosesau canlynol:

- Canfod yr holl agweddau amgylcheddol sylweddol, gan gynnwys y rhai sydd o ganlyniad i newidiadau
- Gweithredu gweithdrefnau rheoli addas, ymdrin ag amodau gweithredu normal, annormal a brys
- Gyda'r nod o leihau effeithiau amgylcheddol ac ariannol, sefydlu amcanion a thargedau, yn unol â pholisïau WAST a'r rhai a gyhoeddwyd gan Lywodraeth Cymru
- Darparu hyfforddiant priodol i'r holl bersonél perthnasol
- Archwiliadau mewnol rheolaidd
- Adolygiad rheolaidd o effeithlonrwydd EGS gan Weithgor Rheolaeth Amgylcheddol. Bydd effeithlonrwydd EGS yn cael ei adolygu'n flynyddol mewn cyfarfod Adolygu Rheolaeth ffurfiol fydd yn cynnwys y Cyfarwyddwr Bwrdd sydd â chyfrifoldeb dros reolaeth amgylcheddol ac uwch reolwyr eraill.

Environmental Policy Statement

The Welsh Ambulance Services NHS Trust (WAST) covers the whole of Wales. Due to its size and the nature of the services it provides, the WAST has a number of environmental aspects which, if not carefully managed, would have significant financial and environmental impacts. As part of its commitment towards reducing these impacts, the WAST will implement and maintain a formal Environmental Governance System (EGS), which will be designed to achieve the following key principles:

- Compliance with relevant legal and other requirements
- Prevention of pollution
- Continual improvement

Effective environmental management will be achieved through the following processes:

- Identification of all significant environmental aspects, including those resulting from changes
- Implementation of suitable control procedures, covering normal, abnormal and emergency operating conditions
- Establishing objectives and targets, aimed at reducing environmental and financial impacts, in line with WAST policies and those issued by the Welsh Government
- Provision of appropriate training to all relevant personnel
- Regular internal audits
- Regular review of the effectiveness of the EGS, by an Environmental Governance Working Group. The effectiveness of the EGS will be reviewed annually at a formal Management Review meeting which will include the Board Director with responsibility for environmental governance and other senior managers.
